



Brookfield Farm Winter Share

Once again, we are pleased to offer you a way to continue to eat the same great locally-produced, farm fare that you've been used to, during the cold winter months. Of course, it will still be seasonal eating (so, we're not talking about melons in February). This is New England, and we're going to eat like it - that means potatoes, carrots, beets, turnips, rutabagas, celeriac, cabbage, squash, onions, kale, and collards. Our goal is to provide your family with a share of these crops into the winter.

*Please remember that this is a **share of the harvest** (and the harvest hasn't happened yet) so quantities will vary. From what we can tell so far, many winter share crops are looking plentiful - carrots, potatoes, sweet potatoes, winter squash, beets, celeriac, turnips, rutabagas - with the rest looking potentially good as well!*

Here's some other details:

- 1) Distributions take place every other week (Mon. thru Sun. 8am - 7pm, Dec. thru Mar.) *self-serve, directly out of the root cellar.*
- 2) The share is *targeted to be the same size as last year* - an average of 30 lbs per month.
- 3) *The produce will not be washed* (too cold for the farmers and the barn water pipes) but will be delicious.
- 4) We will have *other local products available for sale* during distribution including eggs, yogurt, and maple syrup.

And here's some Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1) *Is the root cellar scary!?* No. Well, it used to be. But now it has great lighting, easy to read signage, and a well-lit staircase!
- 2) *If I miss a distribution can I make up for it?* Yes!! You can double-up on any distribution to make up for any missed one.
- 3) *What if it snows?* We plow and sand our parking lot regularly.
- 4) *What if I don't eat potatoes, can I take other vegetables?* Yes. While our share has guidelines, you can mix and match most items. The exceptions are onions (limited) and squash (all distributed in December).

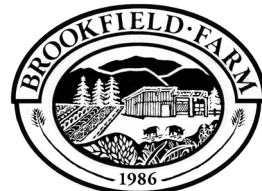
